

Dryer Vent and Vent Cap Installation Instructions

INSTALLATION

Make sure the duct is sized correctly for the vent and well anchored to the structure for stability.

STEP 1

Select a good grade of exterior-type silicon caulk or equivalent appropriate to the local climate and usage. Following installation instructions, apply a sufficient amount of caulk around the neck of the vent as shown in Sketch No. 1. This will assure a good airtight seal at the vent/duct connection.


STFP 2

Insert the vent into the duct and press firmly to compress the caulk for a good seal at the duct.


STEP 3

Apply caulk around the outside edge of vent at the wall as shown in Sketch No. 2. This will assure a good weather tight seal at the wall opening. Wipe off any excess. The vent openings must be positioned at the bottom.

We recommend a good grade of exterior-type silicon caulk or equivalent. Apply caulk according to manufacturers instructions.
